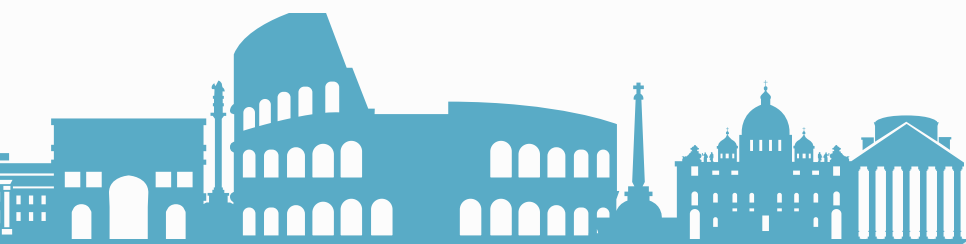

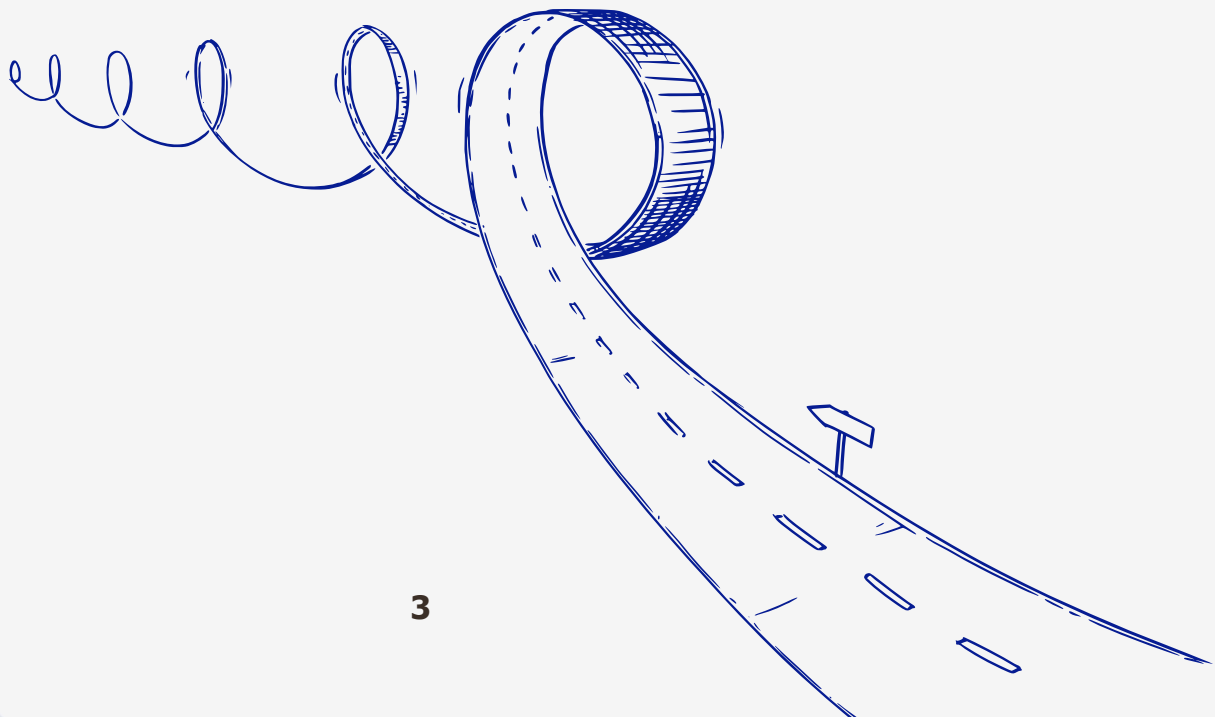



From Ciampino Airport...

... to the COLOSSEUM and the ROMAN FORUM


Reaching the heart of Rome from Ciampino Airport is the first step toward discovering the rich, centuries-old heritage of the Eternal City. This guide provides clear, practical, and up-to-date information on how to reach the Colosseum and the Roman Forum—located within one of the world’s most important archaeological parks—in a way that is safe, accessible, and suitable for all visitors.

There are several ways to make this journey, each offering different advantages in terms of travel time, comfort, and accessibility.



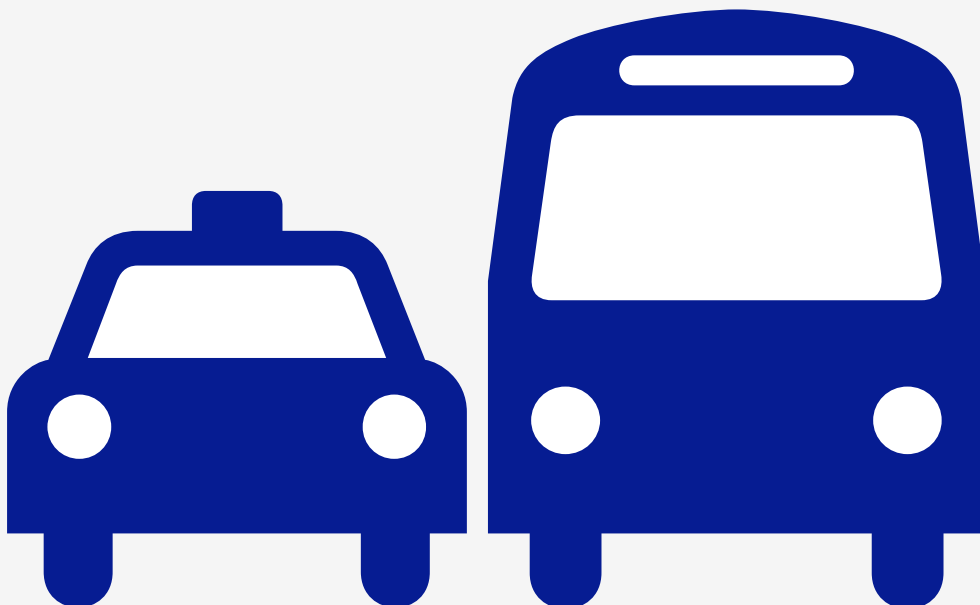


Option 1: Take the **Ciampino AirLink** service from the airport to **Ciampino Station**, then continue by regional train to **Termini Station**, Rome’s main railway hub. From there, you can continue toward the archaeological park by taking **Metro Line B** in the direction of “**Laurentina**” and getting off at Colosseo, or by using buses or other accessible services.



Option 2: Use direct transport options such as private transfers, accessible taxis, or dedicated shuttle services—particularly suitable for those who prefer, or require, minimal transfers.

Note: The number of accessible vehicles is limited, so advance booking is strongly recommended.

This guide will help you choose the most suitable route based on your needs, providing detailed information on:

- Transport accessibility
- Assistance services available at the airport and stations
- Architectural barriers along the route
- Travel times and recommended options for passengers with disabilities

Whatever option you choose, the goal remains the same: to reach the Colosseum and the Roman Forum comfortably, safely, and with ease—so you can begin your visit to Rome in the best possible way.

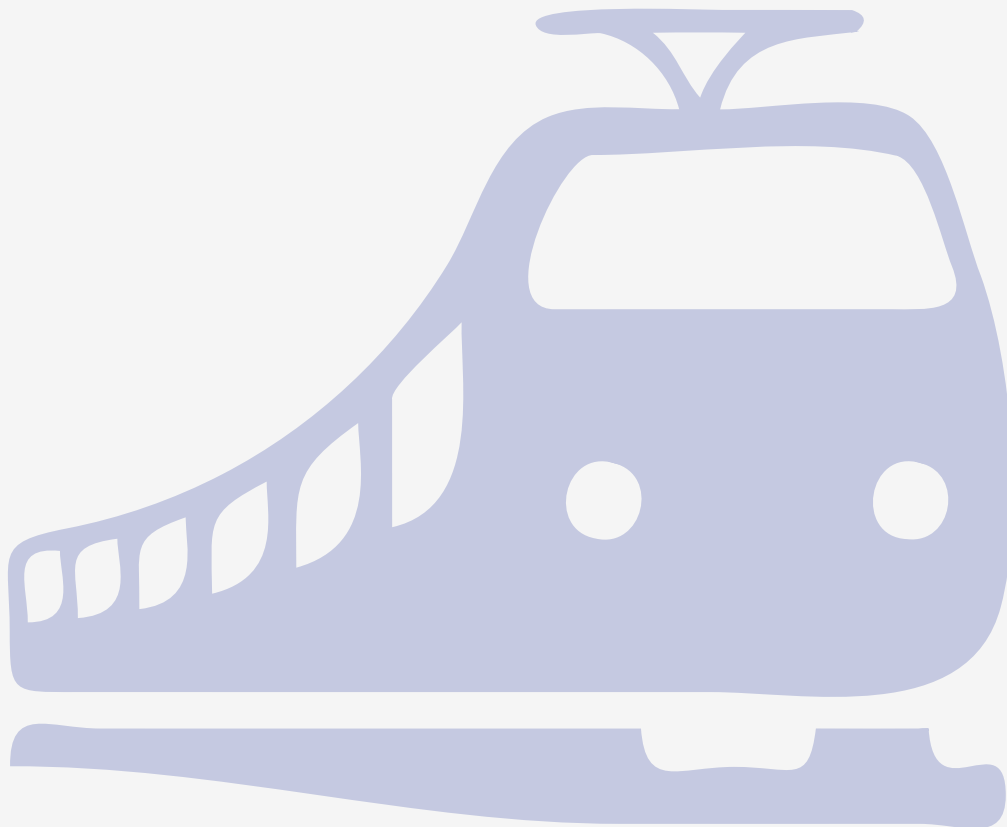


SOLUZIONE 1:

SHUTTLE + REGIONAL TRAIN + METRO B

Ciampino Airport is equipped with LOGES tactile paving and a tactile map, as well as clear visual signage and display screens. However, there are no audio announcements or visual emergency alerts. Exit ramps with handrails are available, while moving walkways and lifting platforms are not provided.

A free **PRM (Passengers with Reduced Mobility) assistance service** is available at the airport and can be booked either through your airline or directly with **Aeroporti di Roma**.



Shuttle

The Airlink shuttle departs just outside the Arrivals area (clearly signposted) and connects the airport with Ciampino railway station.

The shuttle runs non-stop and reaches the station in approximately 10 minutes. The route to the shuttle is generally smooth and easy to navigate, with clear signage and a ramped crossing; however, tactile paving (LOGES) is only present along the initial section.

The ticket includes the regional train to Roma Termini.

The shuttle is equipped with a boarding ramp and offers a designated space for securing a wheelchair.

From here, take a regional train toward Roma Termini.

Trains run frequently (every 12–20 minutes), and the journey takes around 15 minutes.

The station provides partial tactile paving (LOGES), visual signage, accessible gates, and step-free access via ramps and elevators to the platforms. However, there is no tactile map and no visual display for audio announcements.

Metro B

From Roma Termini Station, take **Metro Line B** toward "**Laurentina**" and get off at "**Colosseo**".

Roma Termini Station is well equipped with clear signage, full tactile paving (LOGES), a tactile map, and both visual and audio guidance systems.

You can move between the different levels of the station by:

- Using the station's stairlift with your wheelchair
- Using moving walkways, accessible turnstiles, and elevators

Note: Handrails are not available in some station corridors.

Colosseo Station is partially accessible: main routes are equipped with stairlifts, handrails, and a dedicated gate for wheelchairs or mobility devices.

Flooring is even and continuous. From the station ramp, the Colosseum is directly in front of the exit; the route is flat and sidewalks are equipped with curb ramps. Ticket access is located along Via dei Verbiti, where a small ramp is available.

Note: Elevators, moving walkways, and escalators are not available. There is no tactile map, and LOGES paths are only partially present within the station.

Per proseguire verso l'entrata del Foro Romano, continuare sul marciapiede di via dei Fori Imperiali fino all'incrocio con via in Miranda. Il percorso è dotato di rampa e segnaletica tattile. L'entrata più accessibile si trova all'incrocio con **Largo della Salara Vecchia** sul lato destro del portone. L'ingresso è dotato di rampa in discesa e ascensore.

OPTION 2: TAXI

Taxi services are available outside the Arrivals Terminal at Ciampino Airport and they can take you directly to your destination.

Fares are set by the Municipality of Rome and the Municipality of Ciampino but may change without prior notice. It is advisable to check the official website romamobilita.it for the latest updates.

Licensed taxis are easy to identify: they are white vehicles with a "TAXI" sign on the roof and a visible license number displayed on the doors, rear, and inside the vehicle.

Note: Not all taxis are accessible. To ensure availability, it is recommended to book in advance and request a specially equipped vehicle.

For some destinations, a fixed fare is applied, which includes all surcharges.

Fixed Taxi Fares to/from Ciampino Airport

For some destinations, **fixed fares** apply, which include any additional charges:

- **Rome city center (within the Aurelian Walls): € 30.00**
- **Tiburtina Station: € 35.00**
- **Ostiense Station: € 30.00**

Journeys starting or ending within the **Grande Raccordo Anulare (ring road)** and traveling to or from the airport **must not exceed € 80.00**.

For all other destinations not covered by fixed fares, a minimum fare of € 35.00 applies.

- **Advance booking is recommended**, specifying the need for a vehicle **equipped with a ramp and space for a wheelchair**.
- **Fixed fare** for official taxis: **€ 40.00** for the route from Ciampino Airport to Rome city centre; **additional charges may apply** if a specially equipped vehicle is requested.



Accessibility at the Colosseum:

- Visitors already in possession of a ticket can proceed to the left from the Colosseo metro station.
- The accessible entrance is located on the side, adjacent to the entrance for groups and the underground levels. It is equipped with a metal ramp and smoother flooring than other access points.
- The Colosseum is equipped with elevators connecting all levels.
- Assistance staff are available, and wheelchairs can be provided upon request.

Note: The Colosseum features uneven surfaces and historical level differences.



Accessibility at the Roman Forum:

Accessible entrance:

- **Via della Salara Vecchia:** this entrance is equipped with a ramp and an elevator providing access to the lower level of the Forum.



Tickets and Access

- **Free entry** to the Colosseum and the Roman Forum is available for visitors with disabilities and one accompanying person. Online booking is required.
- Visitors must present valid documentation to confirm eligibility for free admission at the entrance.
